Manuscript should be written in A4 size paper, single line spacing, font type Sabon LT Std (font is included in the article template download link), font size 10, with the margin as follow: Left 30mm, Right 20mm, Top 20mm and Bottom 20mm. Please make sure that you do not exceed the indicated type area.

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acknowledgements in a separate section at the end of the manuscript and do not include them on the title page, as a footnote to the title or otherwise.

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References must be listed at the end of the paper. Do not begin them on a new page unless this is absolutely necessary. Authors should ensure that every reference in the text appears in the list of references and vice versa. Indicate references by last name and years in the text.

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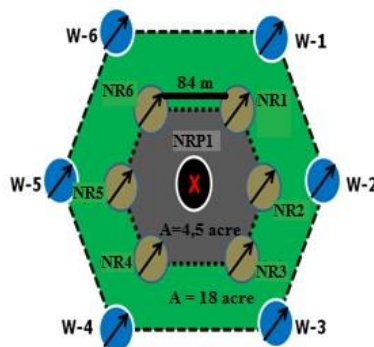


Figure 1. Example of figure.

They should also be separated from the surrounding text by one space.
